Software #1 – Browser Toolbar

How To Create Your Browser Toolbar

Step 1: Go to <http://www.conduit.com/>. Conduit.com is a site that allows web publishers (like you and me) to create browser toolbars to facilitate the ease of communication between the publisher and your readers.



Step 2: Click on the “Get Started Now” button and start creating your account.

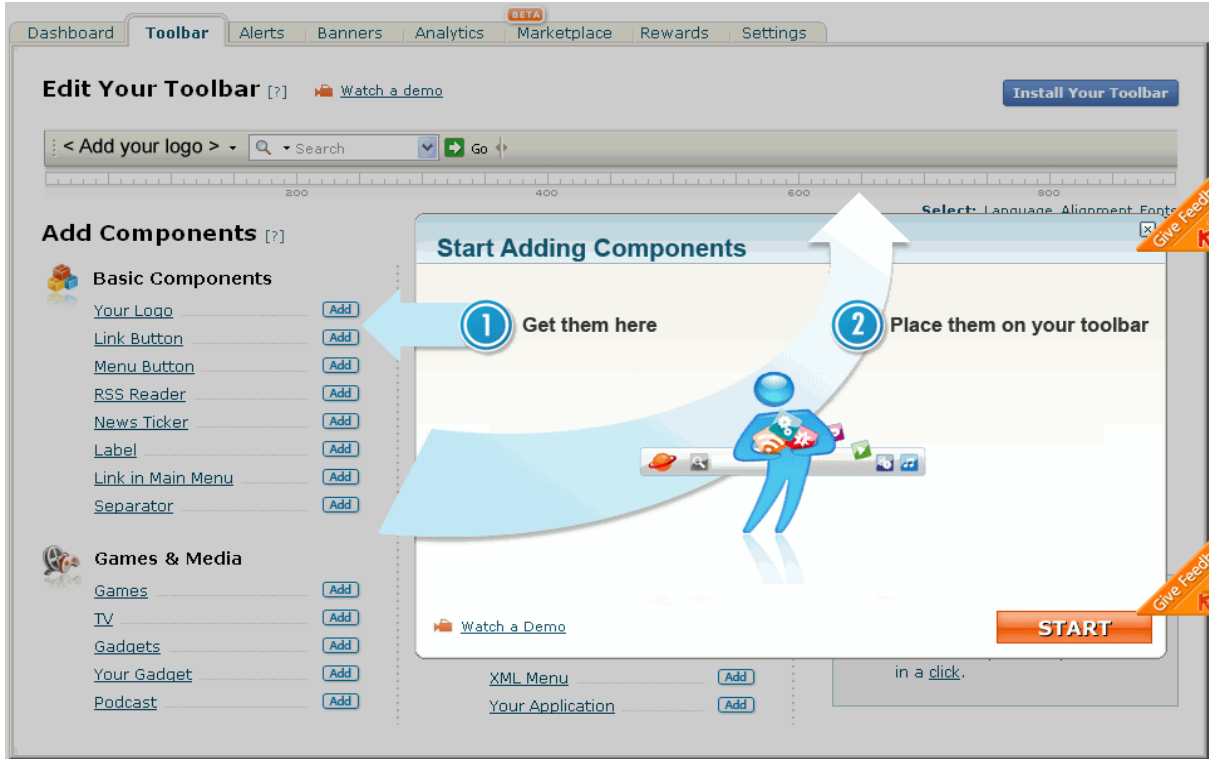

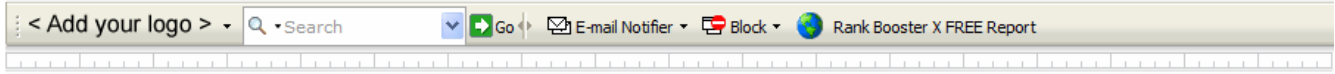



Software #2 – Screensaver

How To *Create* A Screensaver

Step 1: Go to <http://www.instantstorm.com/download> and download your FREE copy of this screensaver creator. Instantstorm basically turns a swf file (*flash file*) into a sceensaver. So the next software you need to download is a flash file creator.



Download the latest stable release

Click the following link to download the latest stable version of InstantStorm (1.5.3) from Download.com:

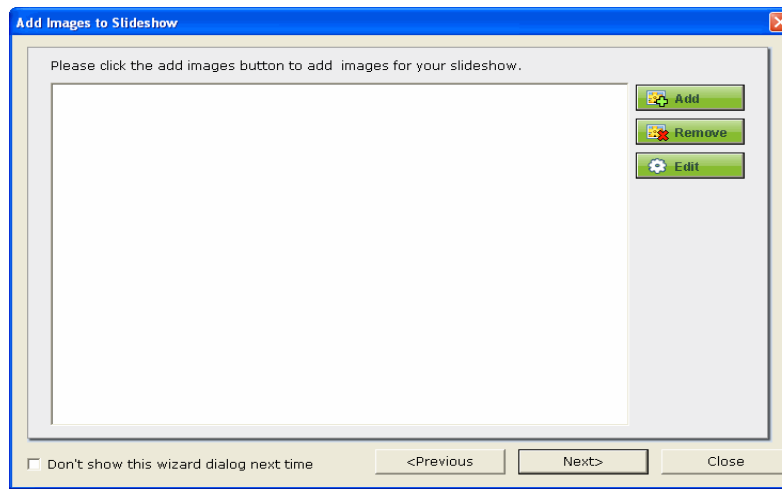

Step 2: Download a flash file creator. You can grab Flash Slideshow Maker 4.88 which is a freeware to create your flash file. Download link is at http://download.cnet.com/Flash-Slideshow-Maker/3000-6676_4-10541568.html

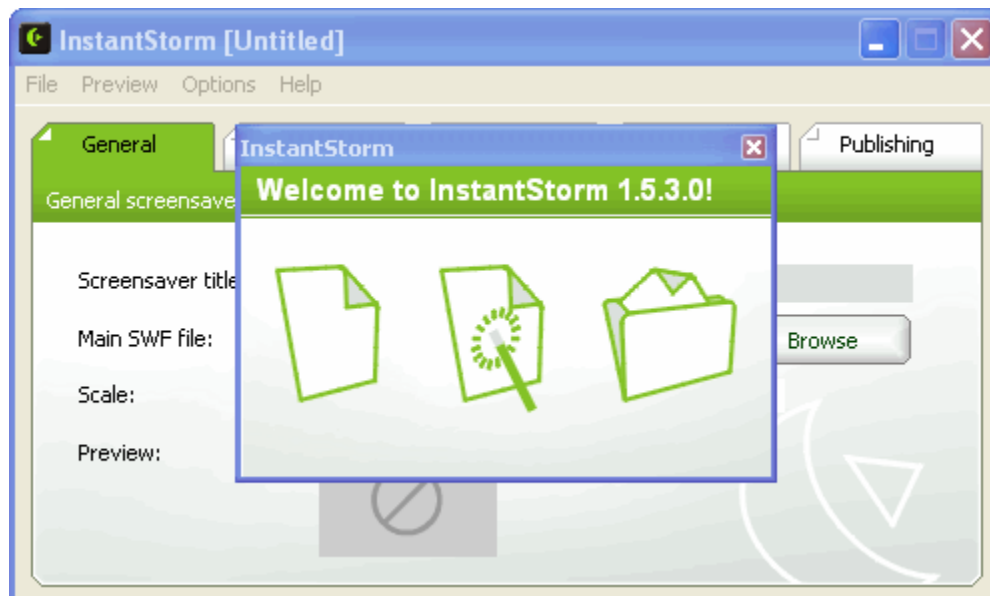
Step 3: You need royalty free images to create your screensaver. You can easily access such images at <http://www.sxc.hu>. **Please only use images that have no restrictions.** And you probably need to resize the images as well, you can use GIMP, a free image editor to do the job - <http://www.gimp.org/windows/>



Step 4: Start Flash Slideshow Maker 4.88 program. Follow the step-by-step wizard to create your flash slideshow.



Step 5: Start InstantStorm, select to create a *New Project with New Project Wizard*. Follow the step-by-step wizard to create your first screensaver.



Software #3 – An eBook in .exe format

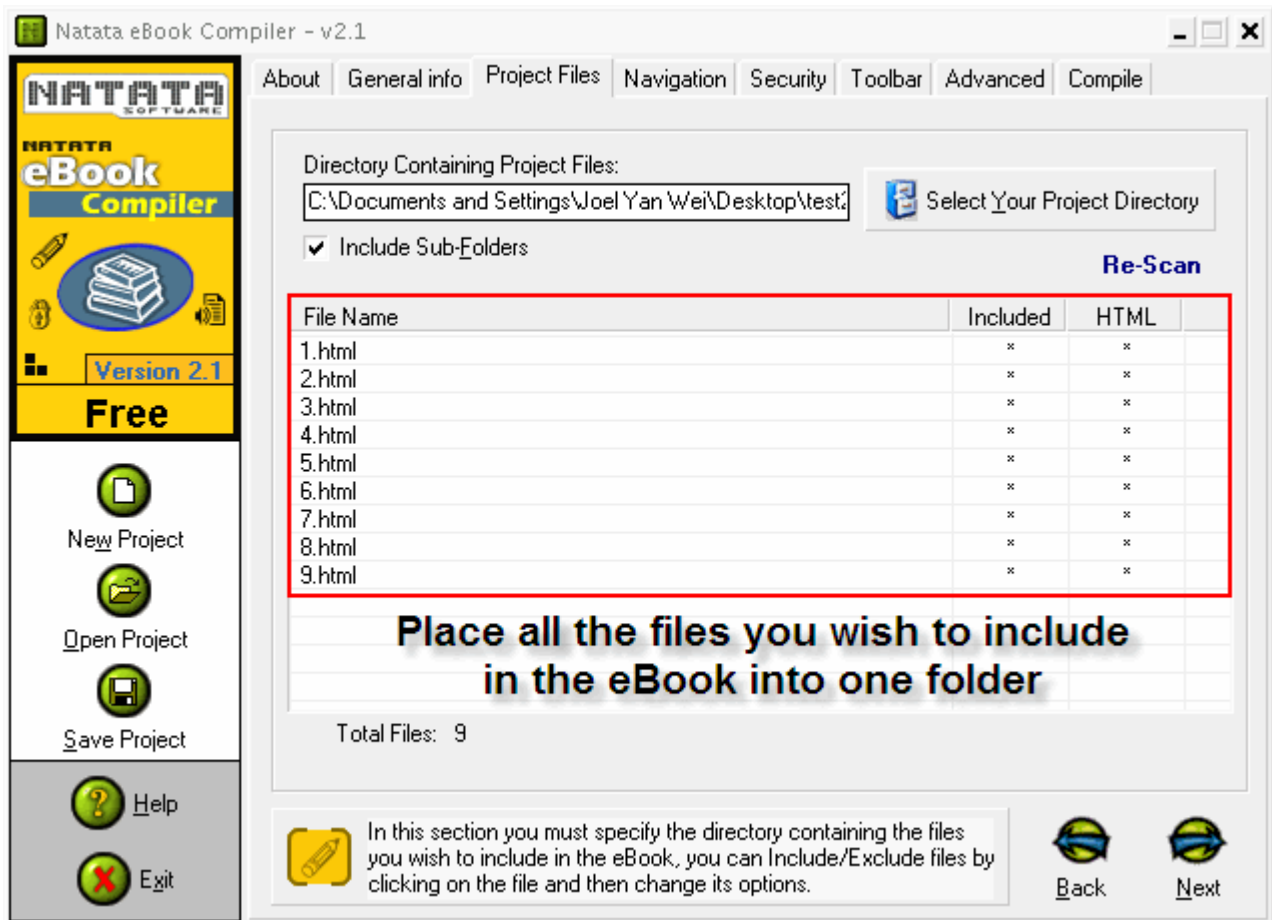
How To Create An eBook In .exe Format

Step 1: Go to http://download.cnet.com/NATATA-eBook-Compiler/3000-2069_4-10169371.html and download NATATA eBook Compiler 2.1. It is a FREE software that converts your HTML files into an executable file instead of a PDF.

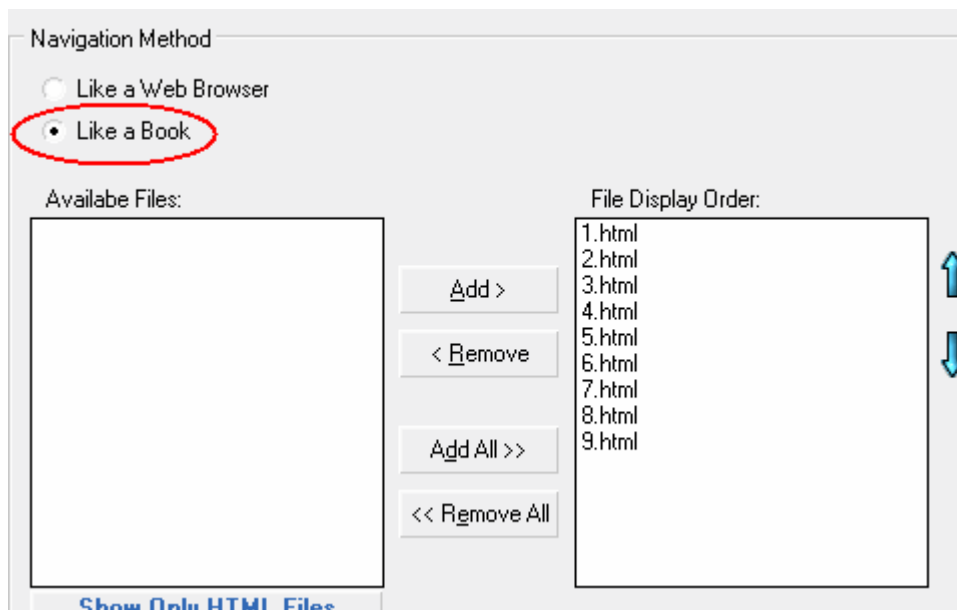


Note: The FREE version allows you to create executable exe files from HTML, wav, gif, jpeg, javascript and DHTML file types. However, it doesn't support Flash, Word docs or PDF files (only its PRO version does)

Step 2: To create your eBook in exe file format, simply follow the steps. Place all the files you wish to include in the eBook into one folder.



Step 3: Select the navigation method to be "Like a Book".



Note: The remaining steps are straightforward. Follow them to the tee and you will have created your first eBook in .exe format.
